- 3. Working as a landscape architect and tasked with monitoring the combined biodiversity net gain on the company's projects and how effective any communication has been in delivering this total
- 4. Working in EIA and tasked with managing compliance with a new legislation on a highprofile project
- 5. Working for a planning authority and tasked with creating a process to monitor success of any changes since declaring a climate emergency
- 6. Working in soil chemistry analysis and tasked with analysing the relationship between peat and carbon to communicate to a customer
